The Spanish Civil War was a bloody conflict that lasted from 1936 until 1939, killing hundreds of thousands of soldiers and civilians. Both sides in the war – left-wing socialists loyal to the government and the eventually victorious nationalist rebels under the command of General Francisco Franco – committed acts of terrible brutality. Estimates of the death toll range as high as one million. In its ferocity, the Spanish Civil War was a grim preview of World War Two. Fascist Italy and Nazi Germany both sided with Franco, and both Axis powers used Spain as a laboratory to test the weapons and tactics they would soon inflict on the rest of Europe. In 1937, the German air force bombed the Spanish town of Guernica, killing hundreds of civilians and inspiring Pablo Picasso's famous antiwar painting, *Guernica* (1937). While Germany and Italy aided Franco's rebels, the Soviet Union supplied arms to the loyalists. Preserving the elected Spanish government became a romantic cause celebre among communists and left-leaning Western intellectuals. Many Americans and Europeans volunteered for the loyalist army. Famous writers, including George Orwell and Ernest Hemingway, flocked to Spain.
