East Japan Railway company will accelerate plans to open one hundred unmanned convenience stores within the next four years, sources close to the matter said June 1, as it takes advantage of the need to reduce human contact amid the coronavirus pandemic. The company's first unmanned convenience store began operation in March at Takanawa gate way station, which opened early that month as the first new stop on Tokyo's Yamanote loop line in nearly fifty years. Utilizing a system Touch To Go Co., a joint-venture company of JR East, stores have around fifty cameras installed inside to identify every item customers pick up.
