Let me dedicate this movie to spread more awareness on the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. The death toll in the Gaza strip of Palestine has reached 10,000 as of November 7th. Since countless innocent lives are being lost, the U.N. Secretary General Antonio Guterres called it a "graveyard for children," that "hundreds of girls and boys are reportedly being killed or injured every day."

In the previous movie about Palestine, I mentioned that the United Nations voted to divide Palestine into Jewish and Arab states in 1947. However, Israel's borders had drastically changed in 1967, after the Six Day War.
