Maussan **claimed** / these grey bodies were 800 and 1700-year-old / "non-human" beings, / but many experts and the public are **doubtful**. // "If it looks too good to be true, / it almost certainly is," / said Jonti Horner, / an **astrobiologist** at the University of Southern Queensland. //

The National Autonomous University of Mexico (NAUM) / did carbon dating to check the age of the bodies. // However, / NAUM said they only tested samples given to them / and did not see the original bodies. // We need independent tests / to confirm what these creatures really are. //

While we are **curious** about aliens, / we need strong **proof** / before we start saying they are here. // It is likely alien life could be much simpler. // For example, / the most **dominant** form of life on Earth / is microorganisms.//
