Choosing this name was important/ as it showed their goal to build a search engine/ which is able to handle a lot of data.// Over the years,/ "Google" has **evolved** into a **synonym**/ for web searching and the internet itself.// The company's **mission**/ is to make information easily **accessible** and useful.// Today,/ "Google" is not just a name but a **verb**,/ which **signifies** its **impact** on global communication and information access.//
