But chasing off evil is not enough.// People bring in fortune/ by eating Ehomaki, / uncut sushi rolls/ filled with seven ingredients / representing the seven gods of fortune.// They are eaten silently/ in one sitting,/ while facing the lucky direction.// This direction changes each year, as it faces the location / of one of ten gods/ which each **govern** luck/ for one year in turn.//
